


THE PURPOSE OF THIS PROJECT IS TO ENCOURAGE READING







THE THEME OF THE KNOWLEDGE QUIZ OF THIS SCHOOL YEAR

QUIZ OF KNOWLEDGE AND CREATIVITY COMES IN TWO PARTS



- **1. QUIZ OF KNOWLEDGE IS SOLVED ON-LINE -**All registered participants were solving the quiz at the same time
- > 374 students from 63 high schools from Croatia
- > From Construction, natural sciences and mining school 10 students were registered
- **2. PRESENTATION OF MULTIMEDIA WORKS -** Digital poster, video clip, animation ... (2-3 min maximum)

It is based on a title from required reading: Johann Wolfgang von Goethe: The sorrows of young Werther and on the subject of the whole competition, the diary as a literary form

> 17 multimedia works from 12 Croatian schools on the level of the whole Croatia were registered

School can also apply students only for the quiz of knowledge, without the multimedia work

PRESENTATION OF THE CREATIVE MULTIMEDIA WORK

- Type of work : **propaganda** (Encourage reading of books from the reading list)
- Technique of creation: the participants can do it as they choose to digital poster, poster, video clip, animation...
- All multimedia work is available on the web page called "Croatian network of school librarians"

TIME SCHEDULE OF QUIZ OF KNOWLEDGE AND CREATIVITY

- The school level was held on 25 November 2016.
- The regional level was held on February 3, 2017.
- The national level was held on April 25, 2017.

THE IMPLEMENTATION OF EVERY LEVEL OF THE KNOWLEDGE QUIZ

- Each student writes individually on the behalf of their school under their name and surname
- Each level in school is supervised by a mentor and two commission members
- At the end of each level, we all get together in the school library



THE SCHOOL LEVEL

- 50 questions of factographic type (2 books required-Goethe: The sorrows of young Werther, Go ask Alice
- The time for online quiz was 45 minutes
- The pass rate was 60% of the solved test

THE REGIONAL LEVEL

- 60 questions factographic type (along with 2 required books- Goethe: The sorrows of young Werther and Go ask Alice is adding the third book Sherman Alexie: The absolutely true diary of a part-time Indian And also questions from writers biography
- The time for online quiz was 50 minutes
- The pass rate was 70% of the solved test

THE NATIONAL LEVEL

- **75 questions factographic type** (along with 3 required books- Goethe: The sorrows of young Werther, Go ask Alice and The absolutely true diary of a part-time Indian is adding forth book-Notes of one high school student
- The questions of bibliography of both authors, genre, conceptual questions and other related details
- The time for online quiz was 60 minutes

• The first three places are rewarded



PRAISES AND AWARDS





• Each student receives a letter of thanks for each participation, and at the National level students receive books for the first three places





ADVANTAGES OF ON-LINE QUIZ

- There are many benefits of an online quiz
 - > Economical, minimum absence of contestants, and members of the committee from the job;
 - > No material costs for travel and accommodation;
 - > Enable schools from the farthest regions of the country to participate
